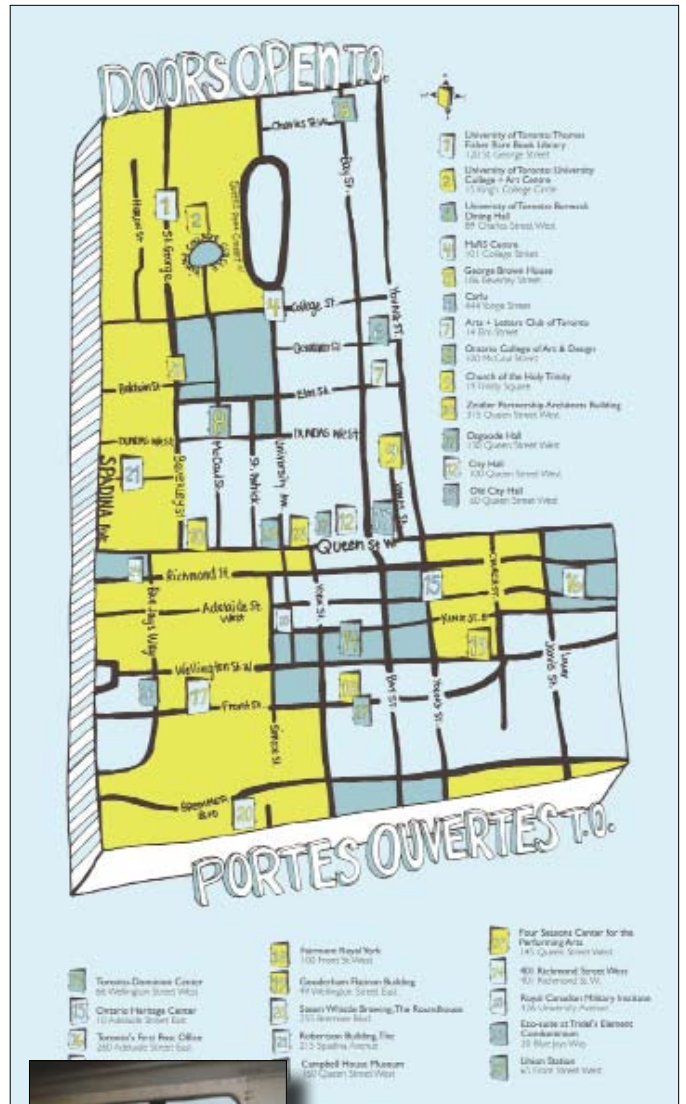
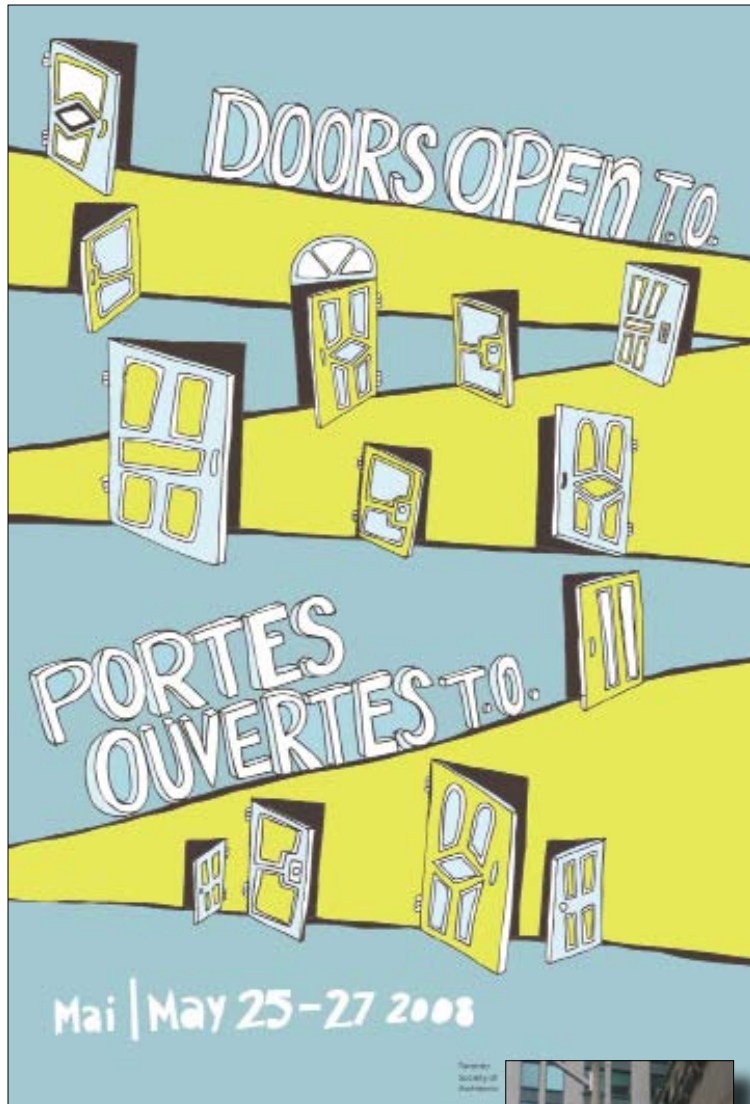


GDC NATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS
